Sesqui State Park

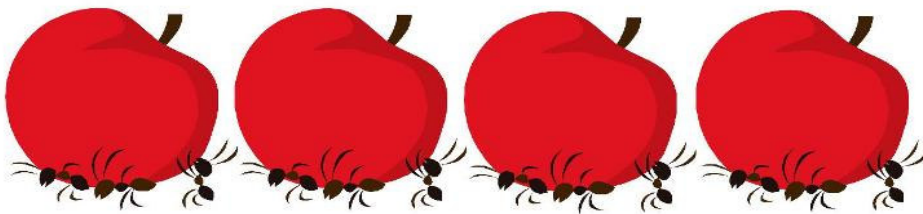
Please join us for a good old-fashioned picnic!

The top sellers who have earned a limo ride to CiCi's pizza with Dr. Hall are:

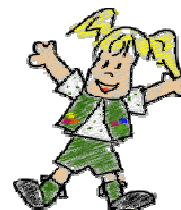

Early Dismissal

A note to new parents and a reminder to returning parents. The District policy for all elementary schools is that students will not be permitted to sign out of school after 2:15 p.m. You must either have them signed out by that time or wait until dismissal and get them in carpool line.

After-Care

Thanks to our after-school care parents for being so timely and paying their tuition the first few weeks of school. This is the best response we have ever had for after-school care payments.

Cafeteria

Cafeteria payments are to be made out to ELW Cafeteria and sent in with your child. You may also create an account on-line at www.nutrikids.com that you can pay by credit/debit card, or you may call the District at 419-2316 and charge by phone. Debt sheets will be sent home as necessary.

Forms

We still have lots of outstanding forms. Each and every one of these forms is important and we need to get them returned so teachers don't have to keep bugging you. As far as the Medicare form is concerned, we still need to have one per child whether they are eligible for Medicare or not. Please fill out their name and sign, the fact that the Medicare # is left blank will indicate they do not participate.

Carpool Information

If someone different will be picking your child up in carpool, please call the office that morning so we will know about it. Be sure to tell them to have your child's name on the visor so no hold-ups in line are caused. Also, if your child is in after-school care and you will pick them up in carpool, please let us know in the office - carpool gets held up by children who we did not know we were not suppose to go to after-school care.

Book bags

We still have several CFK book bags available for \$20.00. Please remember this is one of only three book bags that are allowed. Please see me if you wish to purchase one of ours.

- Option 2:** Order an LL Bean Original Book Pack (item #TA49165) through LL Bean Cost \$24.50 plus tax & shipping. There are many color/pattern choices.
- Option 3:** Find a JanSport Trans backpack. This is an older style, so it can be difficult to find. But if you find it, it will meet our requirements.

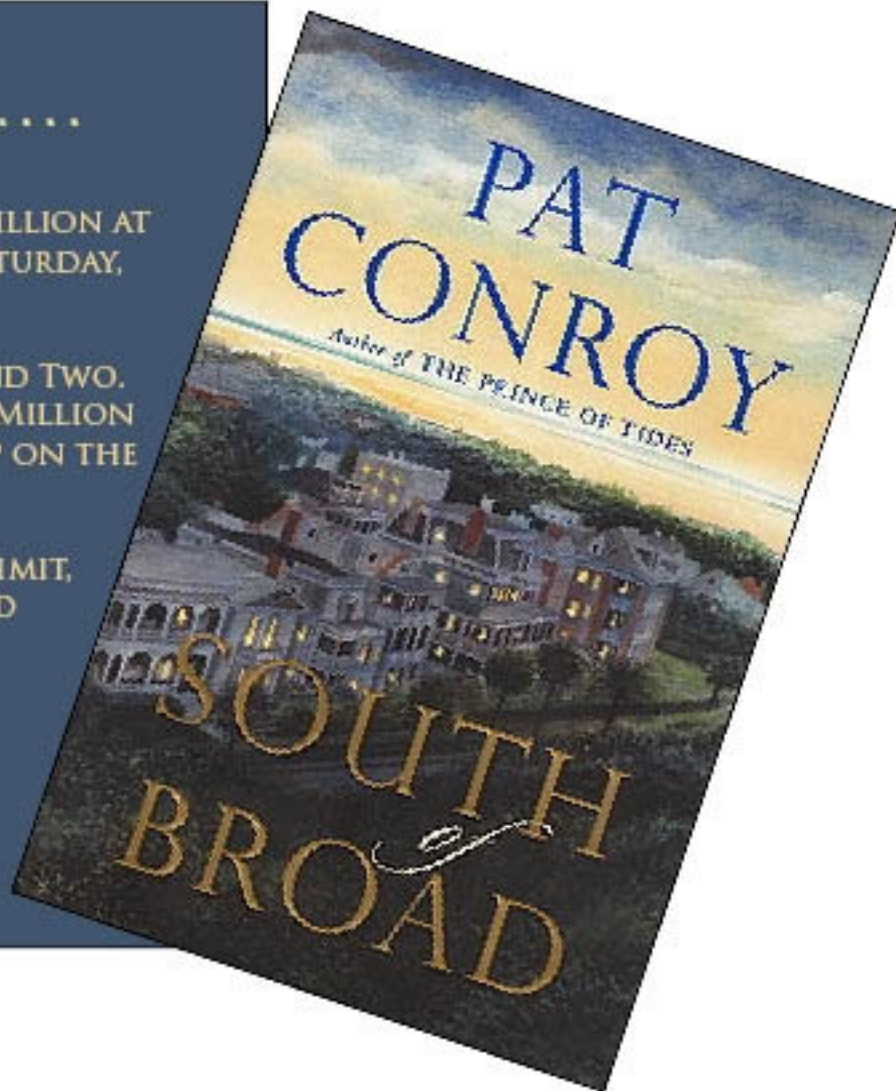
